this is the final volume in richard pipes magisterial history of the russian revolution covering the period from the outbreak of the civil war in 1918 to lenin s death in 1924

grigorill zinoviev for a number of years lenin s closest collaborator was himself a central figure in the bolshevik party s history the lectures he gave on the 25th anniversary of the founding of its precursor the russian social democratic labour party in 1898 provide a lucid account of bolshevism s formative years up to the overthrow of tsarism in 1917 replaced by a succession of stalinist falsifications
